


Figure 1 Components for HQ Meter Software Upgrade

Software Upgrade for HQd Series Portable Meters

Use the following procedure to upgrade the instrument software in HQ30d and HQ40d portable meters. Upgrading the software requires a USB flash drive that contains the new software and the components shown in [Figure 1](#).

Software Upgrade for HQd Series Portable Meters

1. Make sure the meter is turned off. Disconnect any probes from the meter.
2. Connect the USB/DC power adapter to the meter and to the AC-DC power supply as shown in [Figure 1](#). Connect the AC-DC power supply to the power cord.
3. Insert the USB upgrade drive into the flash upgrade port on the USB/DC power adapter ([Figure 1](#), item 5).
4. Plug the AC power cord into an electrical outlet.
5. Turn on the meter. The software upgrade will automatically begin. The meter will display “Updating to HQd_xx.mot” and then display the logo. Wait for the meter to beep (approximately 15 seconds).
6. After the meter beeps, remove the USB flash drive from the USB/DC power adapter. The meter will power off.
7. Turn on the meter. Verify that the software version (HQd_xx.mot) that is displayed on the meter matches the software version that is displayed on the upgrade drive.

Note: The software version is displayed when there are no probes connected to the meter. The software version can also be displayed by pressing **OPTIONS** and selecting **Meter Information**.
